



Recovery Premium Grant and Curriculum at Deanshanger Primary School

September 2021 – July 2022 Reviewed November 2021

As with all schools, we are in a period of rebuilding and resettling. The last eighteen months have taken their toll on our children, staff and community, and we are now intent on moving forward positively whilst recognising the key areas of support that are needed. These include social and emotional support, building stamina and resilience, supporting reintegration of groups (in line with covid guidelines), building upon prior learning (in school and from home learning) and identifying and supporting gaps in learning. We will be supporting all children in our support but this document should be read in conjunction with the Pupil Premium Grant document as there are overlaps identified needs and the support.

Our strategies to do this are numerous and are very dependent on the needs of each child and cohort. It is very likely that our plans will change as we go through the year if different priorities arise and previous 'concerns' show rapid progress (perhaps due to rustiness rather than a gap in either knowledge, skills or understanding). Assessments, both formative and summative, will guide our plans too.

The external situation with covid will impact on our plans and we sincerely hope that we are able to have a consistent run of daily lessons in class with a move towards lifting final restrictions that are in place, rather than moving back in to tighter routines. The impact of covid on staffing continued to make school life tricky. We are committed towards minimising the impact of covid on our children and staff wherever possible.
