From this clip we would like you to choose at least one of the following activities to do. Please send this to your teacher by the end of the week:

1. Write a description of 'Paper' from 'Rock's' point of view or a description of 'Rock' from 'Scissors's' point of view or a description of 'Scissors' from 'Paper's' point of view.
2. Create a setting description of a character's home.
3. Create a wanted poster for Scissors.
4. Write the dialogue between Rock and Paper when Rock is trying to persuade Paper to come with him.

About half a page of writing is a good target for these tasks but try to remember to use: adverbial phrases, adverbs, ambitious vocabulary, expanded noun phrases and a range of punctuation.

EXTRA FUN: You could also try to make 3D models of the characters Rock and Paper at home. Be creative, there is no right or wrong way to do this. You could collect different small stones whilst on a walk with your parents to help make the Rock.

### Human Ear
