



Good morning and welcome to another week of home schooling. It was great to see lots of you on the zoom call last week. Don't worry if you didn't make it, we will set up another zoom call for this week too! Heads up though, the zoom quiz for this week will have a section on the human body!

In addition to the activities below, each child will need to send an email to their teacher summarising the work they have completed for this week via their parent's email. This is important as it gives a sense of purpose for the learning that is being completed at home and it also allows us, as teachers, to reward the children for their efforts. It doesn't need to be a long summary but it may help you at home to encourage the children to complete their work if they know their teachers are requiring them to let us know what they have done.

From this clip we would like you to choose one of the following to do and send in to your teacher by the end of the week:

1. Write a comparison with Mario Kart (which some children will have played, if not then play it or look at this link to help you <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TqJPL3NzoUs>) When writing a comparison you need to include; Descriptions of what you are comparing, good parts of each, bad parts of each, what you like the best and why, how they could be improved and evidence from each to back up your opinions.
2. Write the back story - Why are they racing? - What are they trying to win? - What happens to the people who finish last?
3. Create your own 'Wacky Racer' to join in with the race. Design the vehicle and write an explanation text about its special features. What secret weapons could it have? What tricks does it have to beat the opposition? Who will drive your vehicle? Where are they from?

Human Eye

Draw and label a cross section of the human eye and then explain what each part does. The bigger the better for this activity, plus you will need to look at the eye side-on when drawing it. The following three videos from you tube will help you to be able to do this.
