



### Q2 My child feels safe at this school




#### Q3 My child has someone in school to talk to if they have any worries



## Q5 My child has been bullied and the school dealt with the bullying quickly and effectively



#### Q6 The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year



## Q7 Success and achievements, inside and outside of school, are celebrated.




## Q8 When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly


## Q9 Does your child have special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND)

## Q10 My child has SEND, and the school gives them the support they need to succeed



#### Q11 The school has high expectations for my child





#### Q13 The school lets me know how my child is doing



#### Q14 There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school



#### Q15 My child can take part in clubs and activities at this school



### Q16 The school supports my child's wider personal development



### Q17 I would recommend this school to another parent



#### Q18 I am happy with the lunchtime provider - Fresh Start



### Q19 School Values are clear and promoted




#### Q20 The school leadership team are visible, effective and approachable


# Q21 I understand the roles that Governors play at DPS and how they influence my child's education



#### Q23 I recognise that the PTA work hard to support school life



# Q24 Staff treat people with equal care and respect, regardless of gender race or religion


